Safe Sanctuaries Policies for Student Volunteers

Under the guidelines of Covenant Church's Safe Sanctuaries Policies, our church always strives to place two non-related adult volunteers in the classroom at all times. In those instances when we are unable to place 2 adults in every room, there will be a team of one adult/one youth (between 16-18 years). Additionally, there will be no less than 4 years difference between the oldest child being supervised and the supervisory people.

Youth Volunteers under the age of 16 are encouraged to be a part of the ministries of Covenant Church. Those under the age of 16 are considered youth assistants and included in leadership <u>in addition to</u> the two adults or one adult/one youth (between 16-18 years). The no less than 4 years difference between the oldest child being supervised and the supervisory people also pertains to youth volunteers under the age of 16.

Playground supervision requires the supervising party be physically on the playground, not in a classroom doorway or watching out a window/door. All gates to the play areas should be latched properly while children are in the area and no strangers should be allowed to enter the area for any reason. Personal visitors with friends should be limited to emergencies only.

All children must be signed in and out for any and all activities. Sign in sheets should be placed at the appropriate doors and must be initialed for entry and exit---please remind parents of making certain this form is completed.
