



With the exception of the Yada Yada Small Group, all Sunday morning adult small groups meet at 9:45am.

All Ages & Stages (Rm #3) This class is made up of adults between the ages of 40-70+ years young! This class enjoys Bible study, prayer and conversation. Currently utilizing the *International Series Bible Study* from Cokesbury, there are several members of the class that rotate leading the lesson from week to week.

FaithLink (Library) Open to persons of all ages, this class has been developed for people interested in conversational learning. Utilizing curriculum that is written weekly by Discipleship Resources, this study group seeks to apply United Methodist theology to the current issues in our community and world. Through weekly discussion, you will find yourself motivated to consider your personal views on important contemporary issues, learn more about United Methodism and consider what it means to be and respond as a Christian in today's world.

Fitzgerald Class (Rm #208) This class is made up of parents of middle elementary through college aged students, between the ages of 30-55+ years of age. Their studies include biblical texts, topical studies and family matters. This group enjoys laughter, conversation, good coffee, and ACC basketball.

Key Class (Rm #8) Named for Covenant's founding pastor, Rev. Mark Key, this class includes adults ages 50+ who attend the 8:30 or 11am services. They currently study the *International Series Bible Study* from Cokesbury.

New Connections (Rm #6) A mixture of varied ages and backgrounds, the class seeks diversity in its makeup and topics. Utilizing the life experiences and interests of those in the class as well as outside speakers for learning, they cover a wide range of topics.

Pathfinders (Rm #207) From mid-30's to 70's in age, this class is a loving group of individuals who seek to understand more fully what it means to be a child of God. This group enjoys study and conversation often utilizing multi-media materials to begin conversation.

Whitlock Class (Rm #10) Our older adult class has a place for people in all different stages of life. Utilizing the gifts of several different teachers and the teachings found in *The International Series*, the weekly lessons are informative, challenging, and inspirational. This room is located just off the Gathering Area of the church and is easily accessible to those utilizing the assistance of a walker or in a wheelchair.

YadaYada Class (Rm 206) This small group ***meets at 11am*** on Sunday mornings for fellowship, conversation, and laid back learning. Originally, this group was started as a young adult group. The original participants have aged and the group has expanded! Now, this eclectic group includes young married couples, single adults, adults parenting children and empty

nesters – all are welcome! They study topics related to marriage and family, communication, life application topics as well as key books of the Bible.
