

Worksite Procedures for Volunteers BUILDING BLITZ May 14-28, 2016

NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 16 IS ALLOWED ON THE BUILD SITE AT ANY TIME!

We look forward to having you participate with us. Please read the following about volunteering at the construction site.

You must have your completed, signed and witnessed waiver already submitted to Habitat prior to build day. You may not begin volunteering until a waiver is completed and turned in and you have signed in and received your nametags.

Time: Meet at the construction site <u>promptly at 8:00 am</u>. At that time, we will go over paperwork, a safety orientation, and assign tasks for the day. Your waiver should be turned in by pre-blitz deadline.

Location: The Washington Terrace Park area off of North College. There are two houses,

1712 Brooks Avenue, and 1716 Brooks Avenue.

What to bring/wear:

*CLOSED TOE SHOES—no sandals or flip-flops allowed on site

*WORK GLOVES

*eye protection/safety glasses

*old clothes, preferably long pants, but when it is hot in the summer you certainly may wear shorts, hat – <u>dress appropriately for the weather.</u> No baggy pants allowed on sight!

*sunscreen

*basic tools, like a hammer, tape measure, pencil, etc. if you have them. Be sure to

put your initials on all of your items

Meals, snacks, water, coffee and Gatorade will be provided on site in the Hospitality tent.
