Activities: Our Summer Camp activities are developmentally appropriate for school age children. Each week has a different theme designed to enrich and engage your child all day long. Please see the weekly theme page for more details.

Cost: The Registration Fee is \$40.00 per family due at registration.

A deposit of \$30.00 will be required for every week of camp you sign up for. Deposit is due at registration. **The \$30.00 deposit is non-refundable**, however it will be deducted from the weekly camp fee.

The weekly fee schedule can be found on the payment agreement page.

Weekly fees include 2 daily snacks, field trips and all your camp activities.

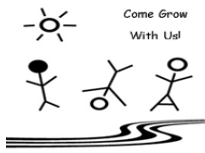
Lunch is not provided by the camp and must be provided by the parents.

Please know that we are a **Nut Limited** facility and would ask that you not send foods containing nut. For example: Peanut butter sandwiches, trail mix with nuts, peanut butter crackers.

Students MUST weigh at least 40 lbs. prior to starting camp with Covenant Kids due to transportation weight restrictions.

To Register:

1. Please complete all forms. We want to be sure we have all the information we need to serve you and your child appropriately, and to insure that you can get the correct weeks.
2. Turn in the completed forms along with the non-refundable registration fee of \$40 per family at registration.
3. Turn in your deposit of \$30 per week for the weeks that you are registering.
4. You will find several "Parent Copy" forms attached for you to keep and use as references through-out the summer.
5. Please mark your calendars for the tuition due dates each week. We request that payments are received 5 business days in advance.
6. Weekly emails will be sent with reminders about the upcoming week of summer camp. These emails will let you know what to send, wear or bring each week.

Helping the Planet, Recycle!

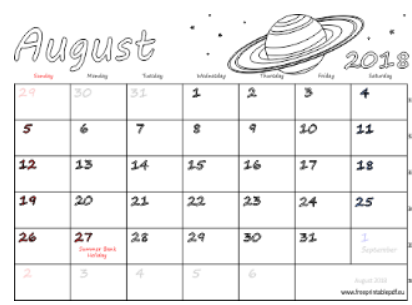
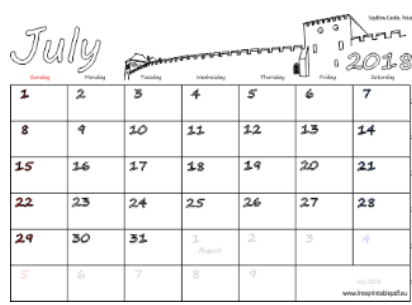
We will be visiting the Recycling Center in High Point, go swimming, create a craft from recyclable material and end the summer with skating.

Some of the fieldtrips and activities might change due to inclement weather.

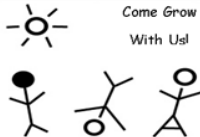

- **Payments:** Make checks payable to Covenant Church United Methodist or CCUM we also accept cash. We do NOT take debit or credit cards at this time. Once payment is received for a week of camp, it is non-refundable after the **due date**, as we have reserved that place for your child and kept another child from enrolling.

- **Registration Fee:** There is a \$40 per family registration fee due at sign -up. This is non-refundable.
- **Deposit:** A deposit of \$30 will be required for every week you sign up. This is non-refundable, however it will be applied to the camp fee for the week you signed up. You will **not** be able to move the deposit to another week.
- **Tuition:** Payments are due 5 business days before the week chosen to attend camp. Tuition must be paid by the due date as indicated below. Tuition includes 2 snacks each day. Lunch is NOT provided. All activity fees are included in the tuition.
- **Returned Checks:** There is a \$25.00 returned check fee. After two returned checks, we require cash or an official bank check.
- **Late Pick Up:** We close at 6:00 PM. Please be diligent in picking up before 6:00 PM. Parents that pick up children after 6:00 PM will be charged a \$1.00 per minute late fee, due at the time of pick up.
- **Days absent:** Unfortunately we plan for every camper to be here every day. We are not able to give refunds due to illness, vacation, or inclement weather.

Discipline and Bus Behavior Management Policy

Covenant Kids Summer Camp Program is committed to your child's safety at all times, whether on the Covenant Church campus, riding on the bus, or participating in a field trip off-campus. Covenant Kids policy on discipline centers on verbal warnings and positive redirection. Please review this policy with your child so he/she understands what behavior is expected of them and what behavior is not appropriate.

Behavior: Inappropriate behavior while attending Covenant Kids includes but is not limited to:

- Disrespect / Bullying of Campers or staff
- Physical harm to others or self (hitting, pushing, kicking, biting, etc.)
- Inappropriate and/or negative language

Disciplinary Action Steps: If a child's behavior is inappropriate, the following steps may be taken:

1. The first account of an incident, the child will be given a verbal warning and redirected.
2. On the second account of an incident, the child will be redirected again so that they may regain control of their behavior. The camper's parent / guardian will be verbally advised of the situation.
3. On the third account of an incident, the child's parent/guardian will be made aware of the situation verbally and with written documentation. The child may also forfeit participation in field trips, if applicable.
4. On any additional accounts, the child will receive a "written behavior write-up."
 - Two behavior write-ups within the duration of the summer camp program will result in the suspension of the child from the program for 1 week or time deemed appropriate by the Summer Camp Coordinator.
 - If the child is reinstated and then receives a third behavior write-up, the camper's parents, teacher and Summer Camp Coordinator will have a conference to discuss options and possible termination from the program.

Suspension: Serious behavior problems may result in immediate suspension from the program. In addition, we reserve the right to suspend a child from our program on his/her first offense, if this first offense is deemed harmful to others or themselves (i.e. hitting, biting, punching, and slapping another child or teacher.) In case of suspension, tuition for the week is non-refundable

Termination: Campers that display continual inappropriate behavior may be asked to leave the program. The Summer Camp Coordinator reserves the right to dismiss any camper from the program whose behavior remains inappropriate after several attempts to redirect. Continual inappropriate behavior may be defined as but not limited the following:

- Behavior that requires constant attention from the staff.
- Behavior that inflicts physical or emotional harm on other campers, self or staff.
- Behavior that ignores or disobeys the rules.

Bus Rules: Students must weigh at least 40 lbs. due to transportation weight restrictions. It is critical that ALL children behave properly as to ensure the safety of everyone on the bus. Students who cause disturbances on the bus are endangering their lives and the lives of others. When riding the bus, it is expected that all children will follow the bus rules. These rules will be presented to students when riding the bus to and from field trips. These rules include, but are not limited to:

- Obey all instructions given by the driver and/or other staff members.
- Stay seated while the bus is in motion with your back against the seat.
- Seatbelts MUST be worn at all times.
- Keep your feet, hands, arms, etc. out of the aisle and keep all body parts inside the bus.
- Use your inside voice.

Health and Wellness

To protect the health and safety of all the children, a child may not attend summer camp if:

- **Fever:** He/she has a fever of 100.0 degrees or above within the past 24 hours. The camper is **NOT** to return to summer camp for at least one whole day once these symptoms have occurred.
- **Respiratory:** He/she has difficulty breathing, severe coughing, or makes a high pitched croupy or whooping sound after coughing. (If the child suffers from asthma, it is essential that the parent fill out a medical form and informs the Covenant Kids staff of what to do in the event of an asthma attack.)
- **Diarrhea:** He/she has had an increased number of abnormally loose stools in the previous 24 hours or while at summer camp. The camper is **NOT** to return to summer camp for at least one whole day once these symptoms have occurred.
- **Vomiting:** He/she has had any vomiting within the previous 24 hours. The camper is **NOT** to return to summer camp for at least one whole day once these symptoms have occurred.
- **Eye/nose drainage:** He/she has thick mucus or pus draining from the eye or nose area.
- **Sore throat:** He/she has a sore throat, especially when fever or swollen glands are present.
- **Skin Problems:** He/she has skin rashes, undiagnosed or contagious infected sores, sore with crusty, yellow, or green drainage.
- **Itching:** He/she has persistent itching (or scratching) of the body or scalp.
- **Appearance/Behavior:** He/she looks or acts differently, unusually tired, pale, lacking appetite, confused, irritable, or difficult to awaken.
- **Lice:** Children with confirmed cases of lice are not to attend until all the evidence of lice and nits are gone. Children who are suspected to have head lice will be taken to the Coordinator's office to be checked, and parents will be notified of findings.

If your child has any of these symptoms, please arrange for alternate care. Please notify the Summer Camp Coordinator if your child will be absent due to an illness. If your child is diagnosed with a contagious disease and has exposed other children and staff, please advise the Summer Camp Coordinator so notification can be given to all parents.

We have a Medical Plan of Action and Medicine Forms for children that have the need of emergency medication (epi pins or inhalers) or have any medical diagnoses that we need to be aware of. All information is kept confidential.

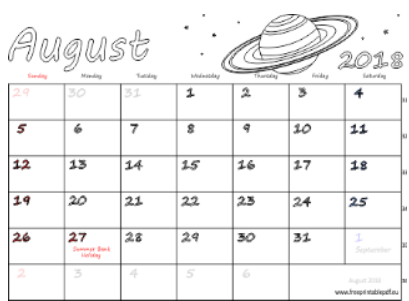
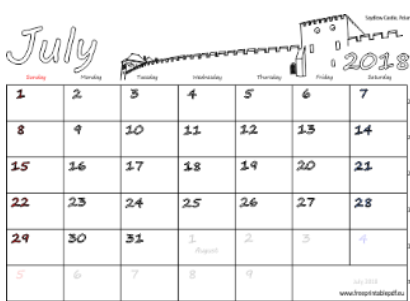
